THE COURSE

Gameplay at The MGC

We have a traditional 18-hole course with six par threes, eight par fours, and four par fives. It should take approximately four hours and 15 minutes to play.

Blue (6213 total yardage), White (6033 total yardage), White / Green Combo Tees (5619 Yards), Green (5246 total yardage), and Gold (5124 total yardage) tee markers are in place on each hole.

Look for the blue (200 yard), white (150 yards), and red (100 yards) fairway markers that will help you gauge the distance from where you are to the center of the green.

The colour of the flag on the green indicates the placement of the green.

- Red flag: pin is on the front third of the green
- · White flag: pin is on the middle third of the green
- · Blue flag: pin is on the back third of the green

The white stakes and fences indicate "out of bounds." Refer to the course layout on the scorecard to locate all hazards. We have 29 sand traps in play. Red stakes indicate penalty areas. Feel free to ask our golf professionals, club captains, or any experienced player familiar with the course if you have any questions..

We ask you to please fix your divots and repair your ball marks, we hope to provide divot fill in our power carts and pull carts sometime this year as well.





FACILITIES

PRO SHOP

PGA of Canada / Head Pro / Director of Golf Gerald Aliling and his staff are here to help book tee times; get you set up with the latest and best in golf wear, clubs and accessories; and book your private lessons and clinics Stop by for a visit anytime. New this season, golf-club fittings will be offered using GC3 launch monitor. Top brands such as Taylormade, Titleist, Ping, and Callaway will be custom fitted. Demo clubs are available for use.

LOCKER ROOM & LOCKERS

Lockers in both the men's and women's locker rooms can be rented for \$25 for the season. Both locker rooms contain shower facilities. Note that golf clubs are not permitted to be stored in lockers.

- The men's locker room is located on the lower level of the clubhouse (go down the exterior stairs opposite the first tee or via the back stairwell.)
- The women's locker room is located on the top floor of the clubhouse beside the Spruce & Iron lounge. The locker room can also be accessed using the exterior stairs that lead up to the balcony overlooking the first tee.

PARKING

In addition to our main parking lot, we have an overflow parking area. This is located on the south side of the main parking lot, between Holes 4 and 9. Parking spaces for those with a handicap permit are located along the tree line on the south and north sides of the lot.

Right of Way: A small section of our main parking lot is marked off with yellow striping. This is a right of way that must remain vehicle-free. No parking is allowed in that area.

CLUB STORAGE

We offer club storage and a number of spaces for pull/electric cart storage for the season. With club storage, your clubs are stored overnight, cleaned after every use and waiting for you by the first tee when you arrive for your round. Be sure to book your cart storage spot early as we have a very limited capacity that fills up quickly.

COMMUNICATIONS TO MEMBERS

We send out a newsletter every week to keep you informed about upcoming events, tournaments, pro shop deals and other important news. We have a mailing list of active members. If you are not receiving the newsletter and would like to, please let us know.

BOOKING TEE TIMES

We have online tee time booking on our website at monctongolfclub.nb.ca (click "book a time"). You can also book a tee time through our pro shop either in person or by calling (506) 387-3850 ext. 1.

- Bookings can be made up to four days in advance for members starting at 6pm.
- Guests may book two days in advance starting at 6pm.
- If you wish to book a guest in your group, please call the pro shop to book your guest.
- Bookings must be made in your name and your playing partner's name(s).
- Pro-Shop attendants are not able to book you in earlier than the four-day rule.

ENTERING YOUR SCORES

If you've purchased your NBGA/Golf Canada subscription through us, you can enter your scores either at the iPad mounted on the wall upstairs by the lounge or online. You will need your login info (username and password) to enter your scores on your own device. If you have lost your username or need to reset your password, feel free to contact us in the office and we can help you out!

CHARGING ITEMS TO YOUR ACCOUNT

In order to have an active account to charge items in the office or the pro shop, you must provide us with an active credit card number. Any charges on your account will be settled up mid-month.

You can also set up a charging account with Spruce & Iron if you would like to do so for food and drinks! Your account with them is separate from the account with the club and they need a credit card number as well to set it up. Charges go through immediately for those accounts.

KEEPING A HANDICAP

A golf handicap is a measure of your best ten games out of the last twenty played. It's good to keep a handicap for a couple reasons:

- it enables you to play in tournaments
- it levels the playing field for friendly games
- it helps you keep track of your progress

The basic premise underlying the handicap system is that every player will try to make the best score possible at each hole in every round and that the player will post every acceptable score, adjusted by Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). The ESC sets a maximum score you can post on any given hole.

After completing a round of nine or 18 holes, record your score to establish your handicap. You can do that either by logging into Golf Canada on your own device or by entering your name in the iPad that's mounted on the wall near the interior entrance to the Spruce & Iron

Golf Canada memberships are not included in your membership, but can be purchased through the office. This year's fee is \$41 + tax.

VOLUNTEERING

We are always in need of volunteers to help out with club tournaments and social activities. If you are interested in helping out in any way, be sure to reach out to us in the office!

TOURNAMENTS

While we're considered a semi-private club, we attract revenue through a number of other measures in order to keep membership costs affordable. One of these measures is corporate tournaments, which are booked on Thursdays throughout the season. We make accommodations for members on those days by offering a members-only shotgun start at 7:30am as well as evening tee times following the corporate event.

CHECKING IN FOR YOUR ROUND

We ask players to check in for their round inside the Pro Shop. Please also note, Power Cart packages are rented per seat, guests and other members without power cart packages must pay for the other seat in the Power Cart. If there are only two Riders in a group, they must share one Power Cart. There can be a maximum of 2 Power Carts per group if there are at least 3 Riders.





ETIQUETTE

MGC is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members, guests and staff. To further this commitment, the Board of Directors has implemented a new Harassment and Violence Prevention Policy.

- This Policy outlines our zero-tolerance approach towards any form of harassment, discrimination, or violence on the club premises or during club activities. We expect members and guests to adhere to this policy at all times.
- The Policy includes guidelines on reporting incidents, investigation procedures, and timelines. A copy of the full policy is included in MGC's Official Policy Manual. This Policy manual is mailed out in a newsletter and a hard copy is available in the administration office.
- We believe that by working together, we can maintain a respectful and inclusive community for everyone to enjoy the sport of golf.

Outside alcohol is not permitted on the course or in the clubhouse. Outside food is not permitted in the clubhouse.

DURING PLAY

Be sure to keep your shadow away from the person who is playing their shot. Avoid walking through a playing partner's putting line. Be quiet when others are playing. Play your ball only when you know the group ahead of you is a safe distance away. Repair divots in the fairway and ball marks on the green. Rake sand bunkers.

PACE OF PLAY

A timely round of golf at our course should take approximately 4 hours and 15 minutes. Aim to keep up with the group ahead of you and follow these tips to play a timely, enjoyable round; clocks have been placed throughout the course as a reminder.

- Finalize your club selection while your partner is hitting, be ready to play tour shot when it's your turn.
- Always take your clubs with you. Do not leave them in a location that requires you to run towards the group behind you in order to retrieve them.
- Take only the few clubs you need to the wrong side of the green (side away from the next tee).
- Do not compile scores on the putting green.
- Play a provisional ball when a ball could be lost or out of bounds and limit searching for a ball to three minutes.
- When on the green, make sure clubs/carts are left in an area that is enroute to the next tee.
- Be ready to start walking as soon as a member in your group hits. Do not wait for the ball to stop.
- Encourage "ready-gold" and "continuous putting" within your group.
- If you are out of contention for the hole or feel that you may be holding up your group, it is
 considered to be a sporting gesture to pick up and move to the next hole so that your
 group may keep its proper place on the course. For handicap purposes, implement the
 Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) rule.
